

Setting sail Lesson 2.1



Fort Rammekens, located by the entrance to the Western Scheldt, was built between 1547-1552. Fort Rammekens is the oldest Western European sea fortress that is still standing. The most important function of the fort, for much of its history, was to guard the shipping route to the harbors of Middelburg and Antwerp.

1 Pilot Ships sailing from the North Sea onto the Scheldt or from the Scheldt onto the North Sea, need a pilot. They cannot do this on their own. This is the case then and now. The Unity welcomed sea pilot Jan Mulder on board on October 1, 1761. He piloted the ship onto the North Sea in a day and a half. Why do you think ships need a pilot – then and now – for the Scheldt entrance?
